Moving forwards with the season – practical changes to the schedule & more.

As promised I am writing to you to make some changes to the season, because of the ongoing changes to the government guidelines we are confident that the first half of our season will not go ahead and have information that event providers here in the UK are now planning for this. However, we are highly optimistic that Worlds, Summit, Barcelona and the latter half of the season will go ahead as planned. In an effort to prepare for this we are going to withdraw entries from the following events:

BCA Spring Spirit (30/01, 31/01) - all teams except monthly teams.

Future Cheer Heart of England (13/02) – worlds and summit teams only.

Legacy Dream Extreme (06/03,07/03) – all teams (please see note below on worlds and summit teams)

Cheer City Spring. Missiles and Baby Grenades.

Instead we will be taking the whole programme (including Baby Grandes and Missiles) to Jamfest Europe (Liverpool 19-20/06) and Future Cheer Nationals (Bournemouth 02-04/07). . Worlds & Summit teams will also be attending Legacy Dream Extreme (06/03,07/03) and FC Adventure in Atlantis 10/04) as additional events. We will also be rescheduling our Showcase to Saturday 20th March from 3pm onwards. Please keep this date free.

Because of this, the total entry fees that are due on November 1st have decreased. The updated amounts for these are as follows:

Practices Moving Forwards

We are currently working on a safe way to bring back stunting to our practices. We are in conversations with Public Health England, Sport Cheer England and various insurance companies, we will be in touch as soon as we have more information on this.

We have also began to incorporate a tumbling element to non-tumbling teams practices. We have done this as we are aware that lots of these athletes already come from a tumbling background or are very keen to learn new skills. We are excited to see what progress can be made within these teams.

Our plan is to continue with skill- based sessions for the time being and then we are looking to begin routine creation/choreography in October.

Merchandise & Competition Uniforms

This year we have decided to make all pro shop items dual year (with the exception of CD season tees, season vests and season hoodies). This means that all items will stay the same for the 21/22 season which hopefully will help given the current circumstances.

Competition uniform payments will remain due as originally stated in the team pack, but just be the lesser amounts. Before entering events we will check that they are fully refundable so we are able to offer you refunds should the worst happen.

We have decided to keep the same uniform for the season 21/22 also, so no one will be buying a new uniform to wear for two events. Jayne will be giving out all uniforms that were sent for repair

pre lockdown at practices this week. We will delay the uniform order slightly later than we normally would in case any EP's make changes. Payment deadlines will remain the same, we will send all invoices via stripe so please don't bank transfer as in previous years. If we secure you a second hand uniform we will let you know and we will adjust the balance invoice accordingly. Once all payments are processed we will send on payments to athletes who have sold their uniform.

Worlds & Summit Teams

As coaches we remain extremely positive about worlds/summit and are excited to keep working hard towards this. All worlds teams and TNT will attend the following events ahead of Worlds still:

Legacy Dream Extreme 6th & 7th March

FC Adventure in Atlantis 10th April

We are going to reschedule and postpone your choreography for the time being and will be in touch with new dates when we have them organised. Practices will run as normal between 14th – 20th October, the dates that were originally pencilled in for choreography.

Finally, we originally said that team cuts would be made at the end of September but we have now decided to postpone this. All athletes are working incredibly hard and we want to give everyone more time to progress, opportunity to stunt and learn and grow as athletes on these teams regardless of if they make the mat teams.

Any money athletes pay towards worlds is fully refundable if you do not make the mat team.
