We are looking for the perfect candidate for our second in house apprentice role, we want to make clear that we are looking for a candidate who would like to establish a career in the cheerleading and gymnastics industry with our previous apprentice going on to pursue a full time career in cheerleading here at CD, coaching 2 worlds teams alongside creating a nationally acclaimed choreography business.

This full time position would suit school leavers or older individuals looking for a career in sport and leisure. Full training provided through our own in-house training programme, as well as through formal cheerleading qualifications. There is fantastic options for career advancement and professional development, it's an incredibly exciting role at a time when The CD is expanding, evolving and advancing.

The apprenticeship will run alongside an appropriate college course, this is likely focused on sports and leisure or we are also open to business administration/ business management roles if the perfect candidate would prefer a qualification in this sector. We are flexible as to the level of course, so if you have just finished school or you have 3 a-levels and 3 years of experience in the workplace we will find and fund a suitable course for you and us as a program. The location of the college day is also flexible with CD being open to arranging something that is close to your own home.

The role is based both at the gym and at an office location yet to be confirmed. Office hours are slightly flexible and will be arranged prior to the role starting at times that are suitable for the candidate and current employees. In the breakdown of hours we make a presumption that the college course will be on a Thursday but this is subject to change.

Job Requirements

1. The applicant should be passionate about cheerleading and gymnastics.
2. The applicant should be positive, enthusiastic and ready to learn.
3. The applicant should be computer literate.
4. The applicant should have a minimum of 5 GCSE's 9-4 (A-C) including Maths, English and Science.

Job Description

The job will be a combination of coaching within the gym setting and the day to day administration of a small and growing business. Daily office tasks may include competition entries, managing our fee and registration system, taking phone calls from prospective members. Gym tasks will include coaching our wide range of teams from levels 1-6, coaching tumbling skills.
